Entry Fees: All adult classes – 50p per class
All children's classes – 30p per class
Children are welcome to enter adult classes but adults cannot enter children's classes!

Prize money: Payable at the showground when you drop off your entries
Adults: 1st £2.00, 2nd £1.00, 3rd 50p
Children: 1st £1.00, 2nd 60p, 3rd 30p
You may collect your winnings at any time on Sunday.

Rosettes Every single childrens' entry will receive a rosette and prize card and every adult entry will receive a prize card.

Special Awards: There are several medals, cups and trophies awarded and these will be presented on Sunday, in the Horticulture Marquee, from 4.30pm. Details on the individual section schedules.

How to Enter: After browsing the schedules, please email the section secretary with the name and contact details of the entrant, and the class numbers they wish to enter. No 'Entry Form' required.
You may submit your entries as early as you like but please make sure they are all in by 9pm on the THURSDAY before the show for Craft, Honey and Horticulture entries. Domestic deadline is the Wednesday before the show at 9pm.
Once the books are closed, there **will not be any more entries accepted**, so please do get in touch before the deadline!

Entry Drop off: Please bring your entries to the Horticulture Marquee on Friday August 8th between 2pm and 7pm OR on Saturday August 9th between 7am and 9am.

Judging: Commences at 10am on Saturday and will usually finish shortly after mid day. The Judges' decision is final.

Entry Collection: Please remember that Chertsey Show is a two day show and we kindly request that ALL exhibits, rosettes and prize cards must remain on the show benches for the whole weekend for all visitors to enjoy. Collection will be after the Awards Presentation on Sunday at 5pm.
If you don't think you can collect your entries on Sunday, please contact the secretary to arrange alternative collection.
Any uncollected entries will be recycled, composted or otherwise disposed of in the most appropriate manner.
